

Section 6.3.2.3 Mass reads:

“The mass of an integral ISOFIX Child Restraint System (Ⓛ-Size Child Restraint System included) combined with the mass of the largest child intended to use the Child Restraint System shall not exceed 33kg.”

This could be misinterpreted by the Technical Services (TS) to mean the 50th% mass for the tallest child.

Please could this paragraph be clarified to read:

Section 6.3.2.3 Mass

“The mass of an integral ISOFIX Child Restraint System (Ⓛ-Size Child Restraint System included) combined with the mass of the heaviest child (as marked on the product, as defined in 14.3.1) intended to use the Child Restraint System shall not exceed 33kg.”
