The roadworthiness package

Commission proposal adopted 13 July on

- Periodic roadworthiness tests
- Technical roadside inspections of commercial vehicles
- Vehicle registration

The roadworthiness package

Periodic roadworthiness tests

- Minimum standards on quality of vehicle tests and inspectors
- Frequency of tests for older cars and cars with high mileage
- EU wide compulsory testing for motorbikes and scooters

The roadworthiness package

Roadside tests of commercial vehicles

- Include light commercial vehicles + trailers
- Selection of vehicles on risk profile of the operators
 - target high risk undertakings
- Minimum quality requirements for roadside tests

Vehicle registration

- Effective enforcement of roadworthiness via the vehicle registration regime

Strategy of action on road injuries

Steps forward

- Maximum Abbreviated Injury Scale "MAIS 3+"
- CARE database adapted
- Commission Staff Working document 2013

Deployment of ITS action plan

Main issues

- Cost-benefit analysis of ITS applications
- eCall
- Free access to road safety info
- Safe and secure parking info

Driving licences

Annexes I and II of Directive 2006/126/EC

- Codes – acquired rights
- Flexibility for driving tests on C and D vehicles with hybrid or semi-automatic transmission systems
 - > + Eco-driving
- Motorcycles used for practical driving tests
- Testing of non-professional C1 drivers
