### Transitional measures

#### Note by the secretariat

1. The following amendments to 1.6.1 and 1.6.5 are proposed.
2. A separate proposal for 1.6.3 and 1.6.4 will be submitted to the Joint Meeting RID/ADR/AND for consideration by the Tank Working Group.

#### Proposals

Amend 1.6.1.1 to read as follows:

1.6.1.1 Unless otherwise provided, the substances and articles of ADR may be carried until 30 June ~~2013–2015~~ in accordance with the requirements of ADR applicable up to 31 December ~~2012~~2014.

Delete the following transitional measures:

1.6.1.16 Animal material affected by pathogens included in Category B, other than those which would be assigned to Category A if they were in culture (see 2.2.62.1.12.2), may be carried in accordance with provisions determined by the competent authority until 31 December 2014<sup>1</sup>.

1.6.1.19 The provisions of 2.2.9.1.10.3 and 2.2.9.1.10.4 concerning the classification of environmentally hazardous substances applicable until 31 December 2010 may be applied until 31 December 2013.

Amend 1.6.5.4 to read as follows:

1.6.5.4 As regards the construction of EX/II, EX/III, FL, OX and AT vehicles, the requirements of Part 9 in force up to 31 December ~~2012–2014~~ may be applied until 31 March ~~2014~~2015.
