The Permanent Mission of Japan to the United Nations and Other International Organizations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Executive Secretary of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe and, with reference to Japan's submission of the status report on the regulations annexed to the AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHING OF GLOBAL TECHNICAL REGULATIONS FOR WHEELED VEHICLES, EQUIPMENT AND PARTS WHICH CAN BE FITTED AND/OR BE USED ON WHEELED VEHICLES done at Geneva on 25 June 1998, has the honor to submit the following status report in accordance with Article 7.4 of the abovementioned Agreement.

“Global technical regulation No.12, GLOBAL TECHNICAL REGULATION CONCERNING THE LOCATION, IDENTIFICATION AND OPERATION OF MOTORCYCLE CONTROLS, TELL-TALES AND INDICATORS (ECE/TRANS/180/Add.12, hereinafter referred to as the “GTR”)
(Reference is made to the notification ECE/TRANS/2005/124/12 dated 30 April 2012)

The Government of Japan is considering the details of requirement for control device so as to decide whether or not the Government will adopt the GTR into its national regulations.

The Permanent Mission of Japan to the United Nations and Other International Organizations in Geneva avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Executive Secretary of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe the assurances of its highest consideration.
