EUROPEAN AGREEMENT ON MAIN INLAND WATERWAYS OF
INTERNATIONAL IMPORTANCE (AGN)

GENEVA, 19 JANUARY 1996

SERBIA: ACCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 10 January 2014.

The Agreement will enter into force for Serbia on 10 April 2014 in accordance with its article
8 (3) which reads as follows:

“For each State which deposits an instrument of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession
after the commencement of the period of 90 days specified in paragraphs 1 and 2 of this article, the
Agreement shall enter into force 90 days after the date of the deposit of the said instrument.”
