### Wording of Special Provision 310

#### Transmitted by the expert from Austria

#### *Summary*

**Executive summary:** The “and” in the first sentence of SP 310 and in the first paragraph of packing instruction P910 (Inf. 55) in relation to the number of articles in a production run does not make sense.

#### Proposal

Change the “and” in the first paragraph of SP 310 to “or” so that special provision 310 reads as follows:

The testing requirements in Chapter 38.3 of the Manual of Tests and Criteria do not apply to production runs consisting of not more than 100 cells ~~and~~ or batteries, or to pre-production prototypes of cells and batteries when these prototypes are transported for testing, if: ...

Change the “and” in the first paragraph of P910 to “or” so that packing instruction 910 reads as follows:

P910	PACKING INSTRUCTION	P910
This instruction applies to UN Nos. 3090, 3091, 3480 and 3481 production runs consisting of not more than 100 cells <del>and</del> or batteries, or to pre-production prototypes of cells and batteries when these prototypes are transported for testing.
