
# Road safety evolution in Kazakhstan, 2003-2014





























## Distribution of road accidents caused by participants

#### Law of the RoK "On Road Traffic" dated April 17, 2014

Decree of the Government of RoK # 1196 "On Approval of the Rules of road traffic; the Main Provisions on adoption of vehicles to Operation; and the List of the operational and special services which transport be entitled to outfit of special flash lights and sounds signals and the painting by especial colour design schemes" dated November 13, 2014

motorcycles and mopeds with a maximum design speed of more than 50 km/h shall be registered with the Authority;

no person shall ride a moped on a road unless he or she has reached the age of sixteen years and is in possession of a valid driving licence (Category A1);

no person shall drive a motorcycles on a road unless he or she has reached the age of eighteen years and is in possession of a valid driving licence (Category A);

mopeds and bicycles with a maximum design speed of not more than 40km/h shall not be used on highway;

no person shall ride a motorcycle without wearing a helmet, securely fitted and fastened on the rider's head.

mopeds and bicycles shall not be used for transportation of passengers
