Acronyms and symbols used in UN Regulations

A. Background

1. At its 103rd session, GRSG noted that the same <u>acronyms</u> have been used in the past in different Working Parties with different meanings which led to confusion and also noted the recommendation of the World Forum WP.29 to establish a list of acronyms to avoid such confusion. GRSG experts have been invited to think about their preparedness to take over part of this important task (see GRSG report ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/82, para. 36).

2. At the March 2012 session, WP.29 mandated the Working Party on Pollution and Energy (GRPE) to establish an informal working group on Vehicle Propulsion System Definitions (VPSD) in order to develop a proposal for a frame system of terms, definitions and classifications regarding vehicle propulsion systems.
