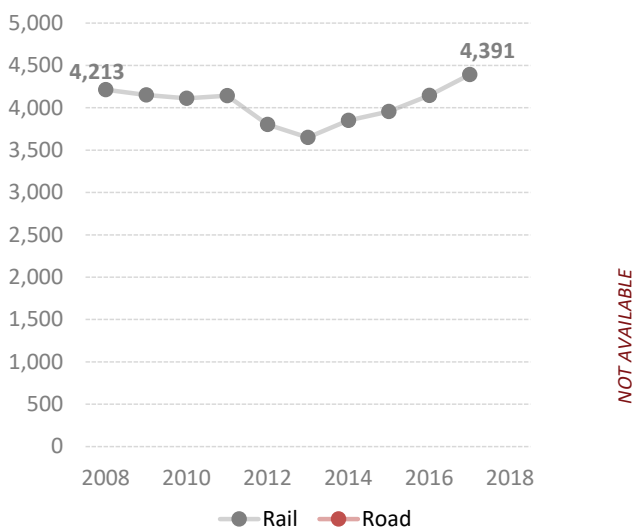

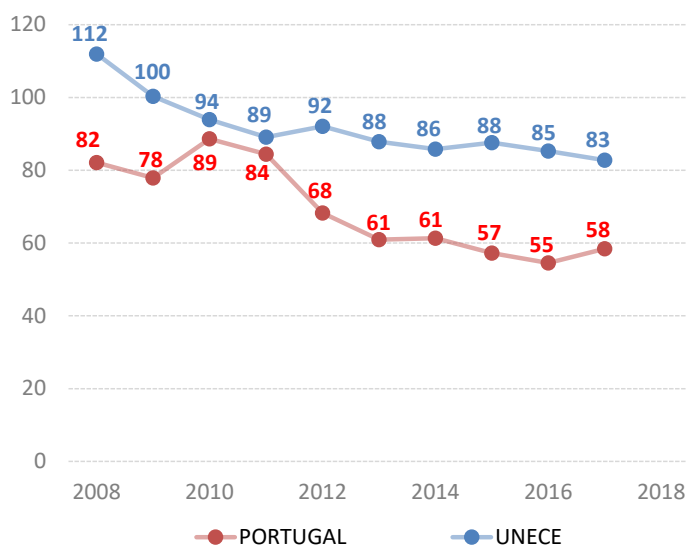

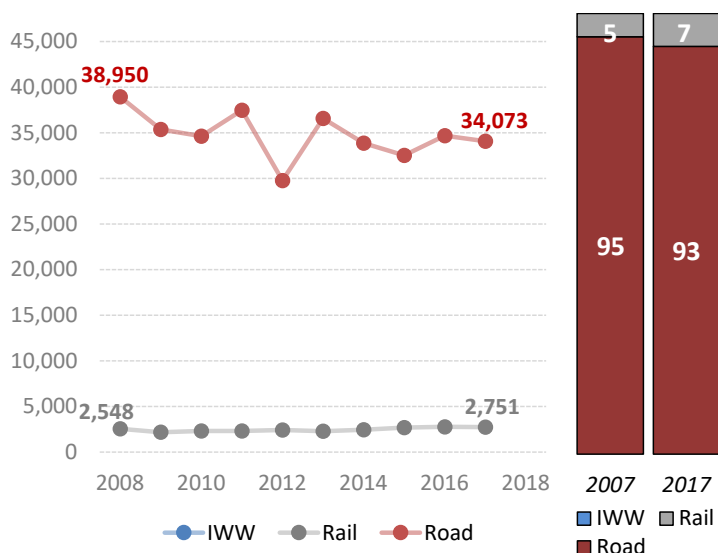
Passenger-km by mode (million) and modal share (%)



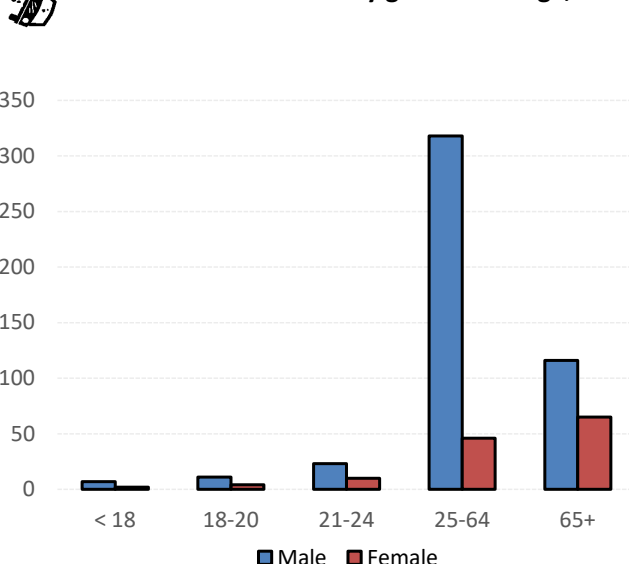
Road fatalities per million inhabitants¹
