EUROPEAN AGREEMENT ON MAIN INLAND WATERWAYS OF

GENEVA, 19 JANUARY 1996

ACCEPTANCE OF AMENDMENT TO THE AGN AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.946.2006.TREATIES-2 of 31 October 2006 concerning the amendment proposed to the AGN Agreement, communicates the following:

Within the period of 12 months following the date of the above communication, none of the Contracting Parties to the AGN Agreement expressed an objection to the proposed amendment. Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 4 of article 12 of the AGN Agreement, the amendment shall enter into force for all Contracting Parties three months after the expiry of this period of 12 months, i.e., on 31 January 2008.
