


- EA1 Increased capacity to exchange secure electronic C2C transit information between the pilot countries and their neighbour countries and trade partners.
- EA2 Increased capacity to **utilize international standard electronic messages** in the field of transit procedures by the pilot countries and their neighbouring countries, in particular B2C information.

#### **Activities**

- Gap-analyses : identify legal and technical obstacles
- 1st inter-regional Expert Group meeting : selection of pilot countries and objectives
- Development and deployment of a secure C2C versatile electronic exchange platform
- Provision of technical assistance to undertake actual C2C exchange of transit data or devise action plans
- Technical workshops to build capacity in the field of C2C exchange and B2C standards
- 2nd inter-regional Expert Group meeting : evaluate the results obtained in each RC
- Seminar to promote the results of the project and, more generally, the benefits of C2C exchange of transit information and the adoption of standards

- 3 gap-analyses have been finalized (ECA, ESCWA and UNECE)
- 2 gap-analyses are ongoing (ESCAP and ECLAC)
