**AMENDMENTS TO AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 1968 CONVENTIONS
ON ROAD TRAFFIC AND ON ROAD SIGNS AND SIGNALS
AND THE 1971 EUROPEAN AGREEMENTS SUPPLEMENTING THEM**

International driving permit

Transmitted by the Russian Federation

1. In the light of the proceedings of the thirty-third session of the Working Party on Road Traffic Safety, the Government of the Russian Federation suggests that it would be advisable to insert the words “provided that the driver holds a domestic driving permit” after the word “Convention” in article 41, paragraph 2 (c), of the Convention on Road Traffic. If this proposal is not accepted, the 1971 European Agreement should be supplemented with a paragraph 26 bis worded as follows:

“26 bis. Ad article 41 of the Convention (Driving permits)

Paragraph 2, subparagraph (c)

This subparagraph shall be read as follows:

“(c) Any international permit conforming to the provisions of Annex 7 to this Convention, provided that the driver holds a domestic driving permit.”
