**AMENDMENTS TO AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 1968 CONVENTIONS ON
ROAD TRAFFIC AND ON ROAD SIGNS AND SIGNALS AND THE 1971
EUROPEAN AGREEMENTS SUPPLEMENTING THEM**

Priority at roundabouts

Transmitted by Poland

1. The provisions of Article 18.4 (a) of the Convention on Road Traffic concern intersections where priority is not regulated by priority signs.
2. Since the regulations which concern priority rules at intersections signed by priority signs are included in the Convention on Road Signs and Signals, any amendments in this respect should be to that Convention.
3. Taking into account the problems raised regarding priority at roundabouts, the following amendment to Annex 1, Section D, paragraph 3 of the Convention on Road Signs and Signals is proposed:

“3. Compulsory roundabout

Sign D, 3 “COMPULSORY ROUNDABOUT” shall notify drivers that they must **follow the direction at the roundabout indicated by the arrows. If the roundabout is indicated by the D, 3 sign together with the sign B, 1 or B, 2, the driver in the roundabout has priority.**”
