Paragraph 6.2.1.2., amend to read:

"6.2.1.2. If a device for indirect vision the total process of scanning, rendering and reset to its initial position together shall not take more than 200 milliseconds at room temperature of $22\text{ }^{\circ}\text{C} \pm 5\text{ }^{\circ}\text{C}$."
