As an expert in petroleum industry, I strongly support the Draft of “Proposed Governance Structure for the Classification and Definition of Fossil Energy and Mineral Resources”. As I know from the Ministry of Land and Resources of China, the UNFC for Mineral Resources has been implemented very well in China. It guided the Chinese old mineral resource/reserve classifications been revised or updated in compatibility with international standards. I believe the UNFC for petroleum will be more familiar in the Chinese petroleum industry. I have committed myself to introduce the UNFC to the industry.

Regarding the comments on the implement of UNFC, I think, a systematic international standard as UNFC should have application guidelines and disclosure regulations or rules besides the classifications and definitions. It is great that as one of the Requirements of a governance structure, the capacity to develop the necessary specifications, guidelines and case studies is required. I hope a practical guidelines will be offered soon.
