



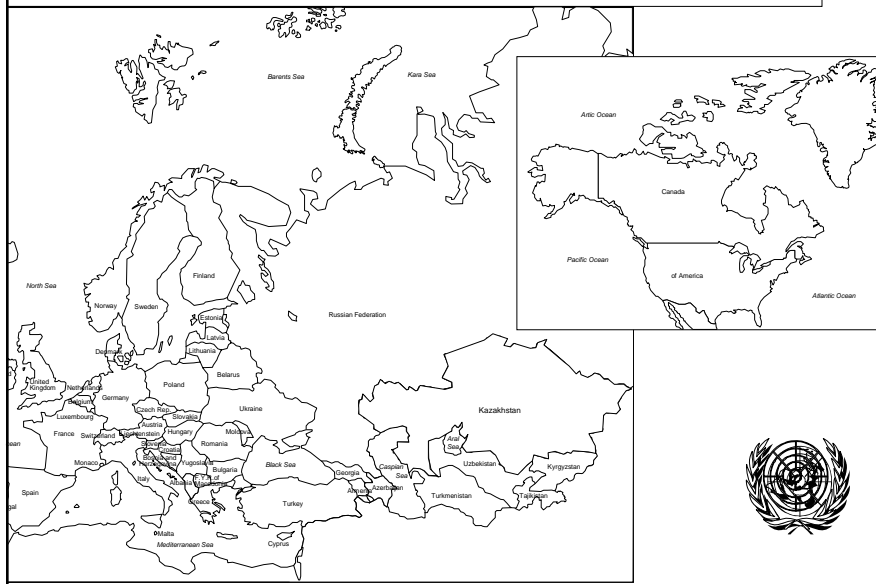

Project Objective

- (i) to strengthen the capacity of air quality management institutions in Central Asia to implement the UNECE Convention on Long-Range Transboundary Air Pollution Convention and its Protocols; and**
- (ii) to promote the deployment of appropriate clean coal combustion technologies (CCTs) for heat and power generation from solid fuels in Central Asia.**



Key Activities air quality management

- **2004-2006: Implementation Plans for the CLRTAP Protocols;**
- **2005-2007: Development of Sub regional Cooperation on Air Pollution Problems as part of the Regional Cooperation under the Convention;**
- **2006-2007: Linking European and Asian Air Monitoring and Evaluation Programmes;**



Implementation Plans for the CLRTAP Protocols

Outputs: a National Concept, a National Strategy and an Action Plan agreed on by authorities in Kazakhstan.



Sub-regional Cooperation on Air Pollution

Outputs:

- **Training workshops on Air quality management and the international legal framework in October 2005; and International air monitoring, data and reporting in October 2006;**
- **Structure for improved sub-regional cooperation on air quality management.**



Linking European and Asian Air Monitoring and Evaluation Programmes

- **Upgrading of one monitoring station in Central Asia.**
- **Delivery of monitoring results according to EMEP requirements.**
