Non-Convention signs – "cycle crossings located at pedestrian crossings"

Submitted by the Chair and Secretariat

Informal document No. 2 (23 June 2022) - prepared by the Chair and secretariat - proposes the image and definition of a "cycle crossing" sign (as well proposals for the sign that combines pedestrian and cycle crossings signs). The Group of Experts is invited to discuss the document.



PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

E, 12 (E-10.0) notifies road users of the position of a pedestrian crossing. The ground of this sign shall be blue with a white or yellow triangle. The symbol shall be black or dark blue. This symbol shall display a pedestrian on a crossing marked by broad stripes. The symbol on this sign may be reversed.

The pedestrian crossing signs shall be placed at pedestrian crossings when the competent authorities consider it advisable.

CYCLE CROSSING

E, XX (E-XX.0) notifies road users of the position of a cycle crossing. The ground of this sign shall be blue with a white or yellow triangle. The symbol shall be black or dark blue. This symbol shall display a cycle on a crossing marked by a file of square road markings. The symbol on this sign may be reversed.

The cycle crossing signs shall be placed at cycle crossings when the competent authorities consider it advisable.

PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE CROSSING

The Group should consider what symbols and/or their elements should the sign which combines pedestrian and cycle crossings contain. Above, there are four symbol elements: pedestrian, cycle, pedestrian crossing road marking, and cycle crossing road markings. The Group should pay special attention to the fact that the location of "pedestrian symbol" and "cycle symbol" will likely be changeable on the sign i.e., either one on top of the other or next to each other. Illustrative examples are provided below.
