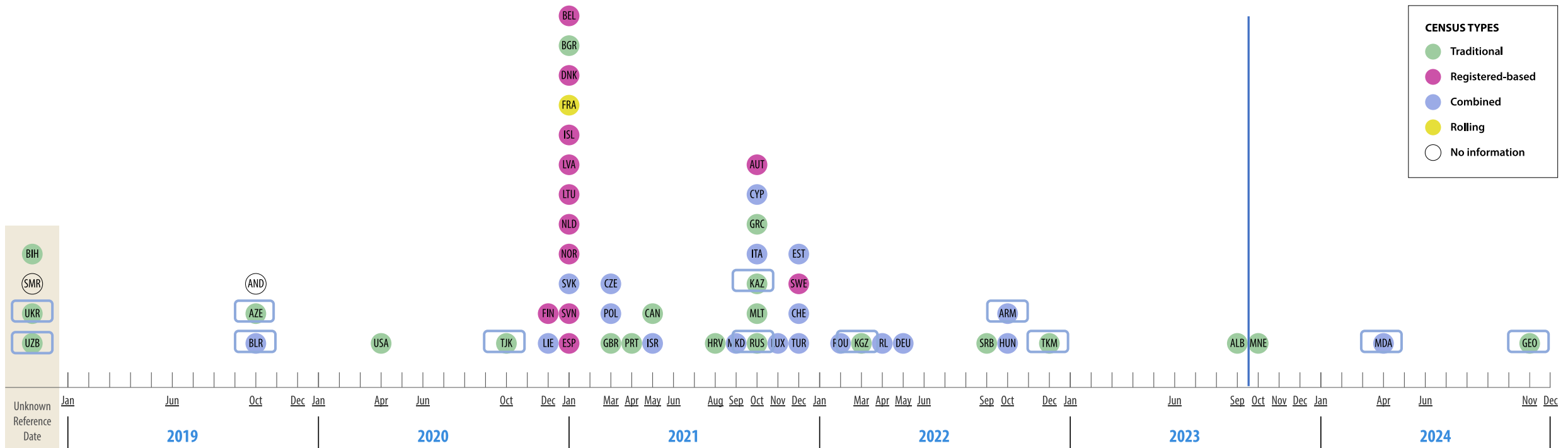


# Timeline of 2020 censuses

49 countries = 88%

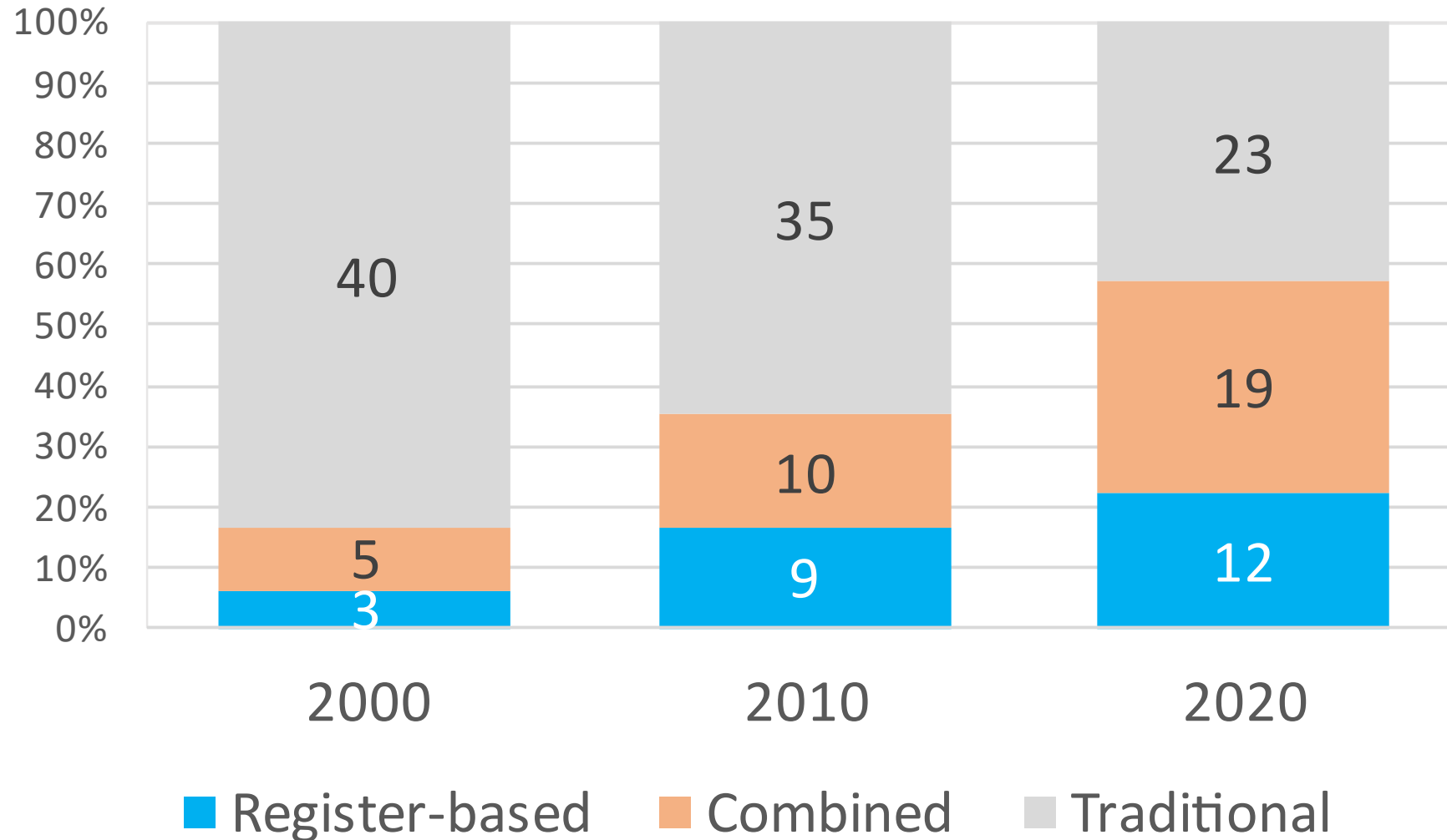


# Work plan on Censuses



- 2023 Sep-Oct: survey of national practices in the 2020 round
- 2023 Oct – 2024 Sep: task forces analyze of survey results, draft Recommendations
- 2024 Oct: expert meeting reviews the draft Recommendations
- 2025 Feb: CES Bureau reviews the draft Recommendations
- **2025 June**: CES plenary endorses the Recommendations

# Censuses and Migration



- From stand-alone census to a better integrated system of population statistics
- The Recommendations project concludes in 2025
- Recording of migration as a key component in the accuracy of annual population estimates. Information on migrants in current population estimates.
- Cross-references in meetings. TF7: Migration
- Consolidate. Expert groups. Steering groups.
- Migration meeting 7-8 May 2024
- Census meeting 2-4 Oct 2024
