Environmental performance reviews:

- Third EPR of Azerbaijan and second EPR of Armenia integrated gender aspects

Water Convention:

- Women, Water and Peace at the 9th session of the MOP to the Convention
- Collection of data on gender aspects in transboundary water cooperation

Protocol on Water and Health:

- Gender perspective mainstreamed in the activities on equitable access to water and sanitation
- Gender disparities addressed in policy and guidance documents

Aarhus Convention:

- Working Group of the Parties, at its 27th meeting, addressed systemic obstacles countries face in effective public participation in decision-making
- Self-evaluation resulted in recommendation to continue to encourage a participatory and human rights-based approach, synergy and gender considerations
