# **Report of the Extraordinary Meeting on Transport, Health and Environment**

#### I. Introduction

1. The Extraordinary Meeting on Transport, Health and Environment was held to discuss a proposal by the Steering Committee of the Transport, Health and Environment Pan-European Programme (THE PEP), at its twenty-first session (Geneva, 23–25 October 2023), to postpone the Sixth High-level Meeting on Transport, Health and Environment.<sup>1</sup> THE PEP is jointly serviced by the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (ECE) and the World Health Organization (WHO) Regional Office for Europe.

#### II. Attendance

2. The Extraordinary Meeting was attended by representatives of the following member States of ECE and WHO in the WHO European Region: Albania, Azerbaijan, Cyprus, Czechia, France, Georgia, Italy, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, Poland, Russian Federation, Ukraine and United States of America.

3. Representatives of the European Union were also present.

## III. Adoption of the agenda

4. The secretariat presented the provisional agenda of the Extraordinary Meeting (ECE/AC.21/2024/1–EUCDE2422320/4.2.1), which was adopted without amendments.

# IV. Election of officers

5. The member States agreed by consensus on a proposal by the representative of Poland that the secretariat chair the meeting.
