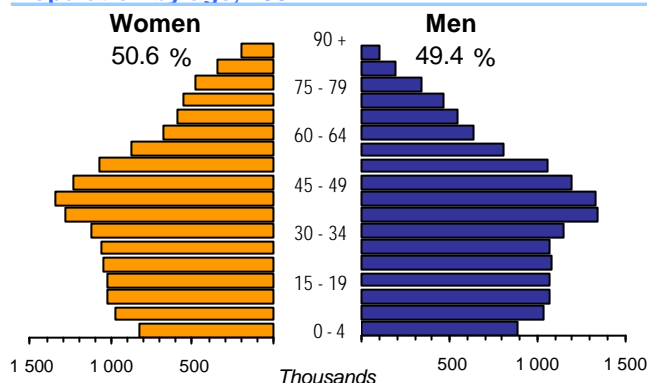

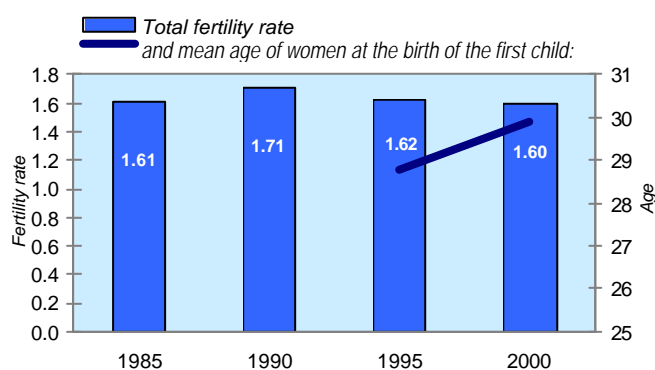

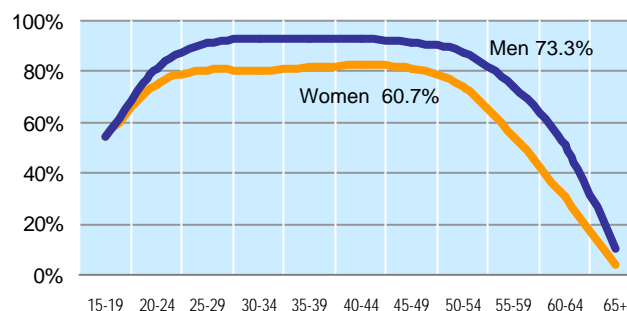

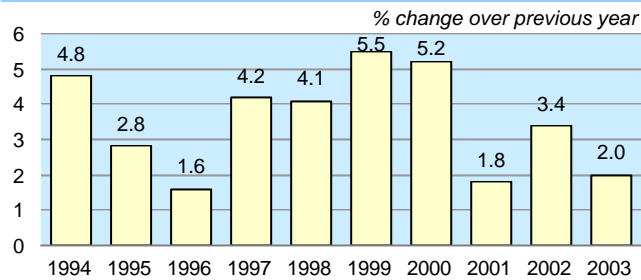

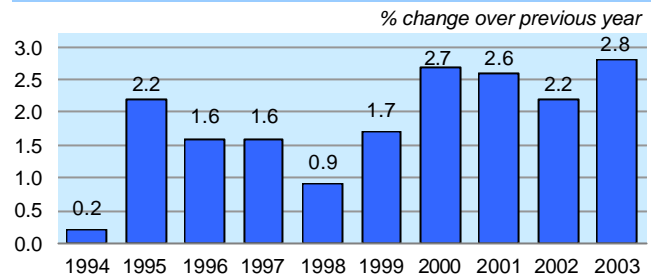

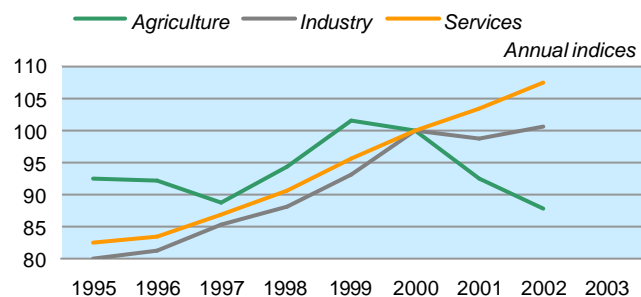

Consumer price index (annual average)



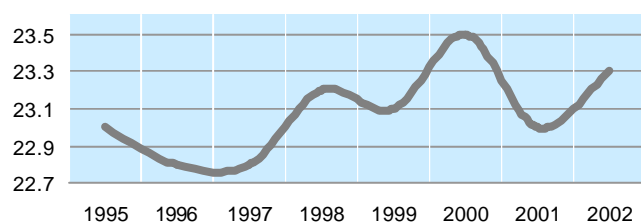

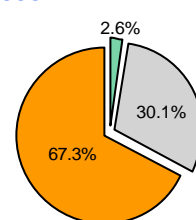

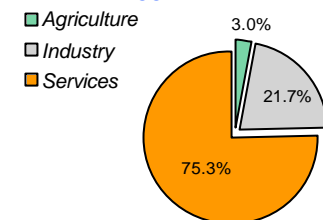

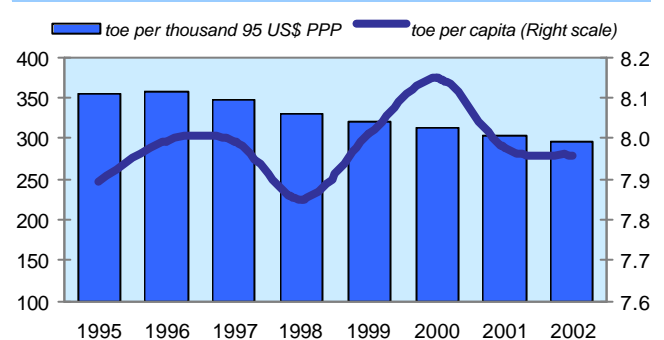
GDP (value added) by major economic sectors: 1998



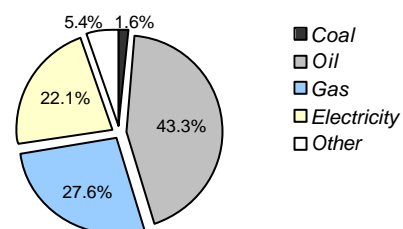
Employment by major economic sectors:^{b/} 2002
