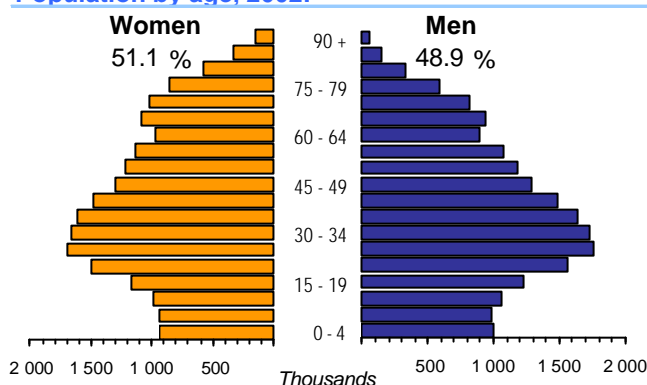

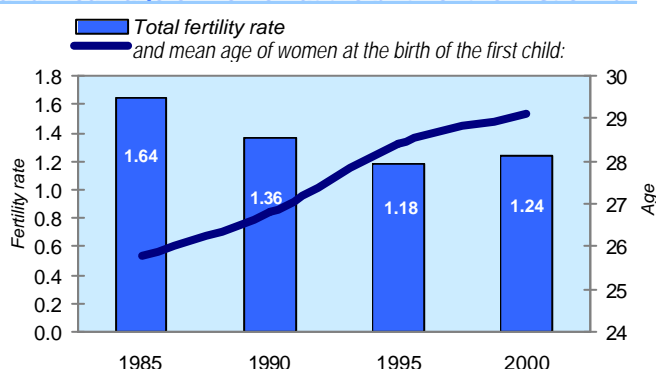

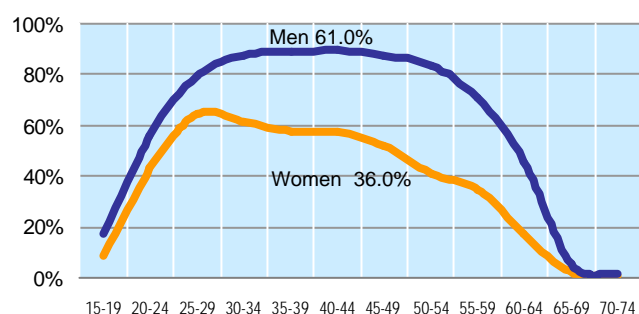

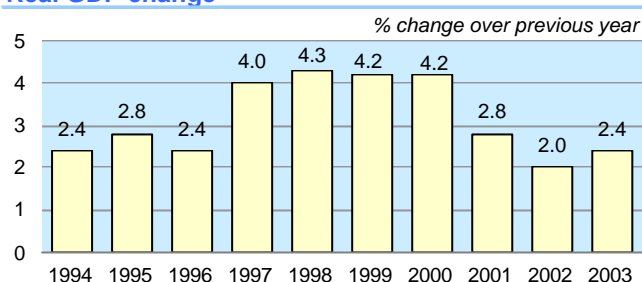

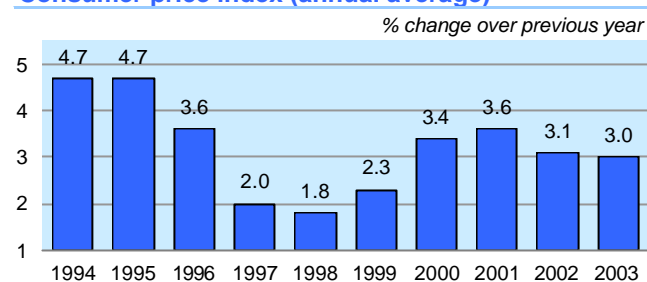

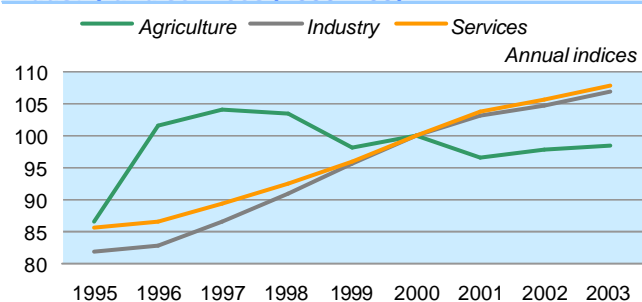

## Consumer price index (annual average)



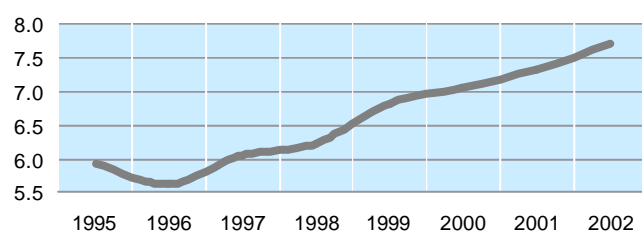

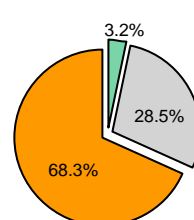

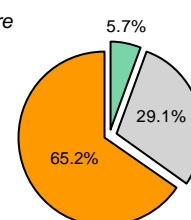

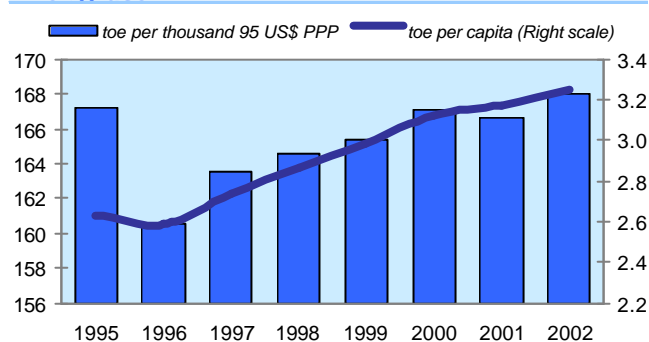
## GDP (value added) by major economic sectors:



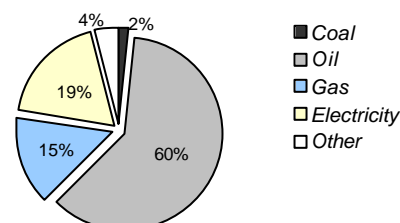
## Employment by major economic sectors:
