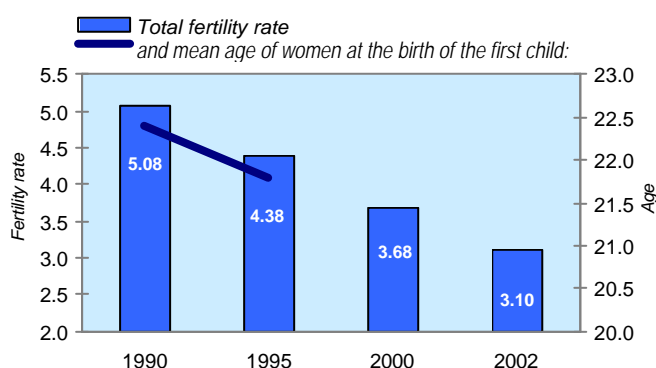

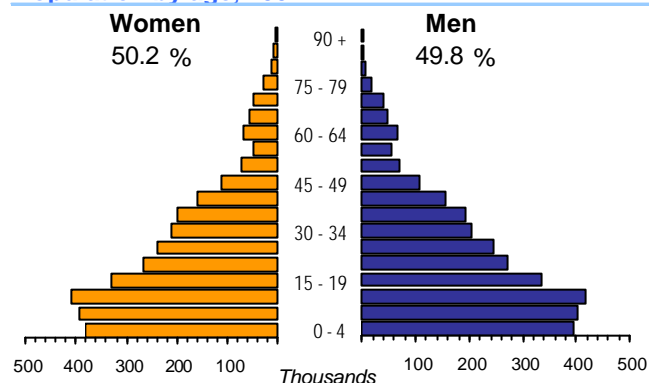
Total fertility rate and mean age of women at the birth of the first child:

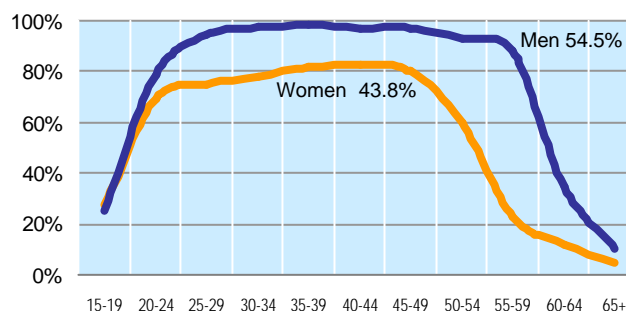

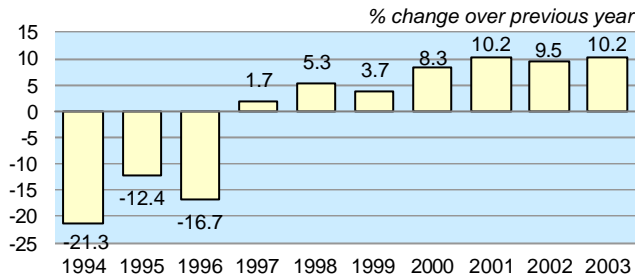

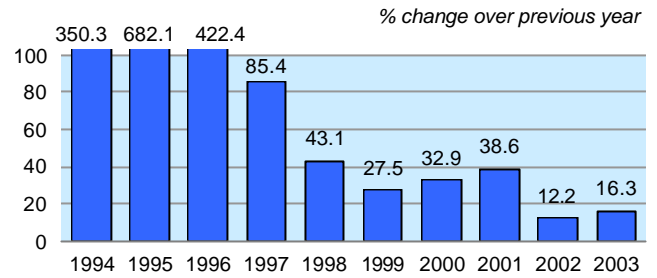

Real GDP change



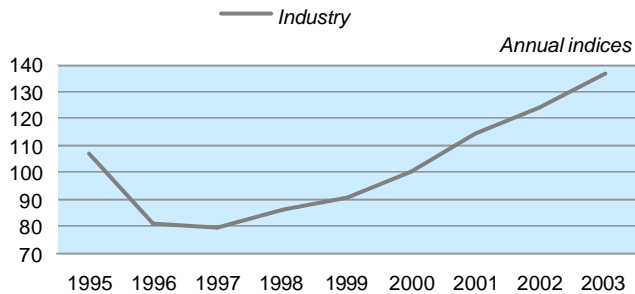

Consumer price index (annual average)



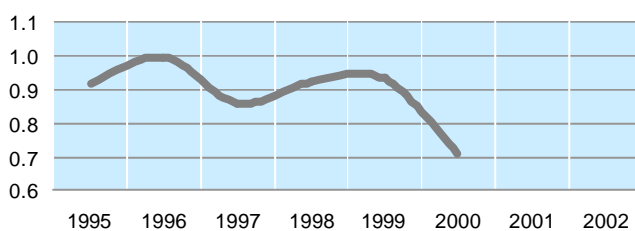

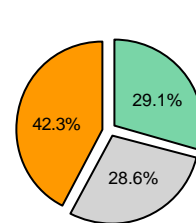

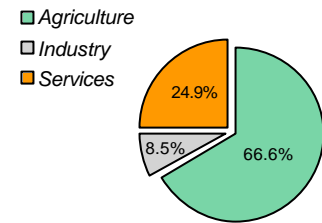

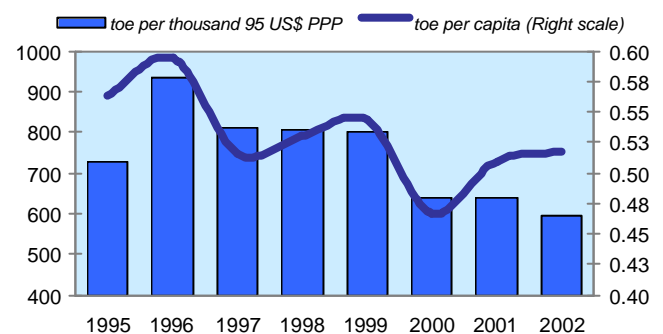
GDP (value added) by major economic sectors: 2002



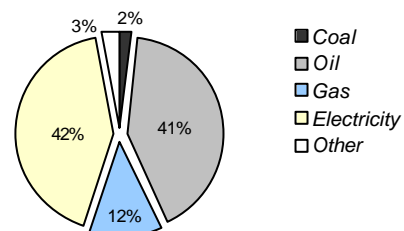
Employment by major economic sectors 2001
