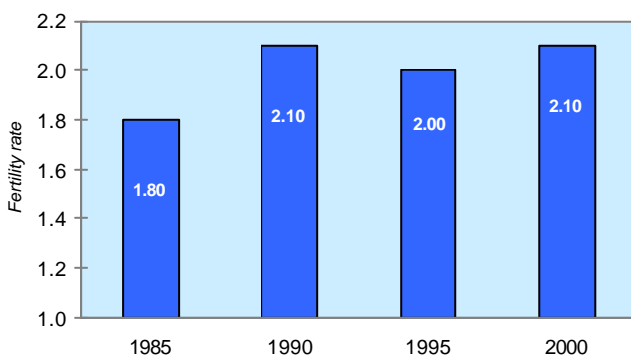

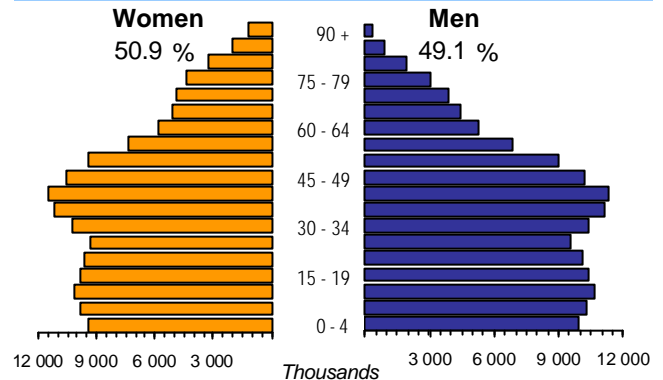
Total fertility rate and mean age of women at the birth of the first child:

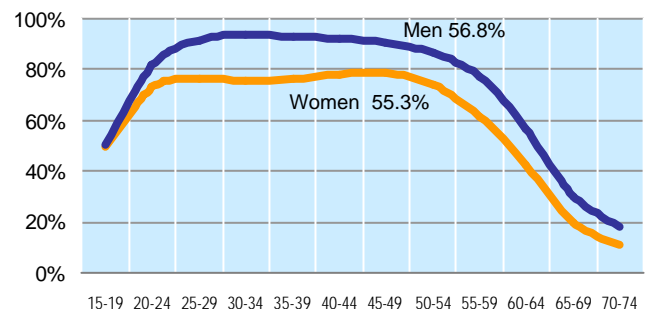

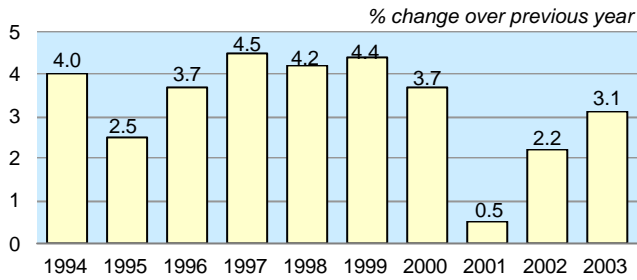

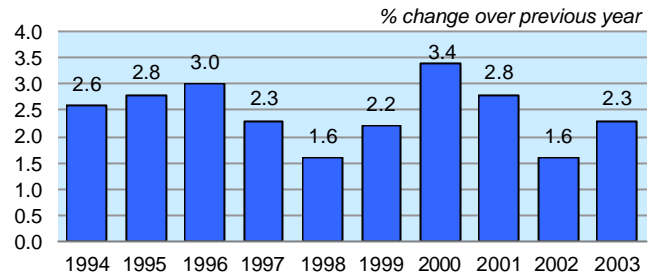

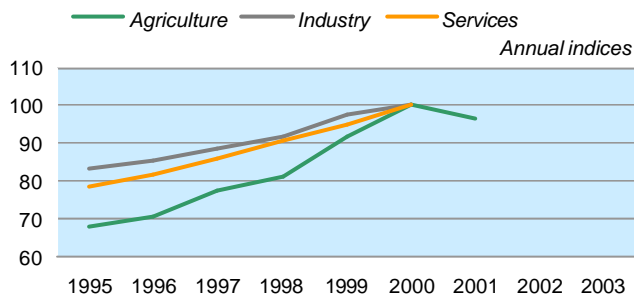

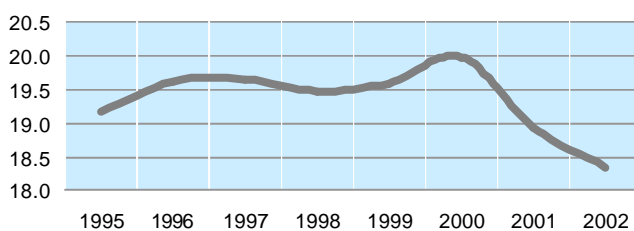

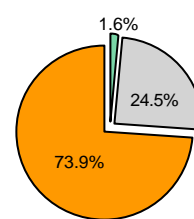

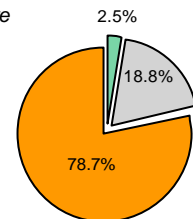

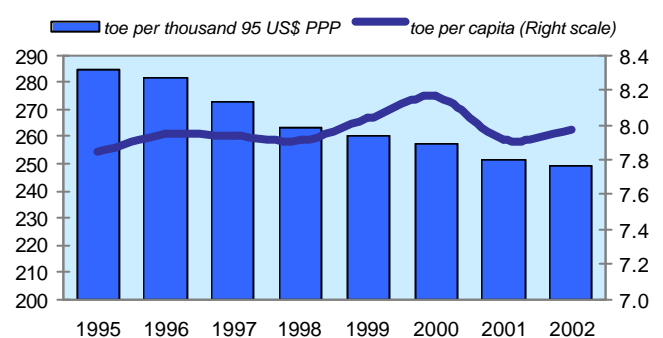
GDP (value added) by major economic sectors: 2000



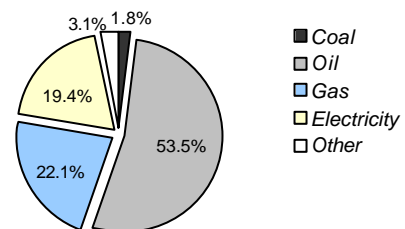
Employment by major economic sectors 2001
