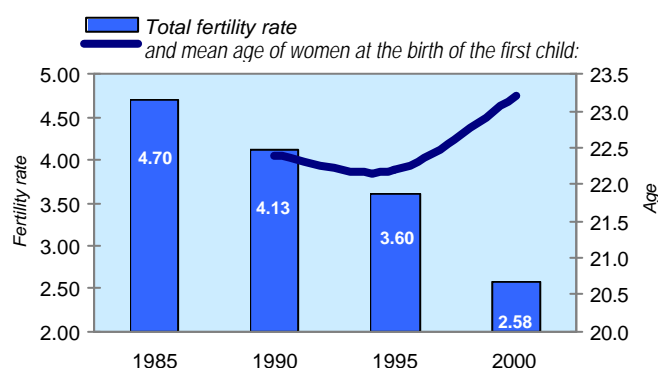

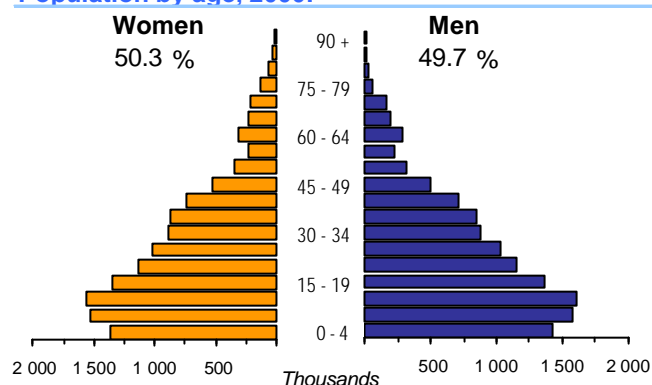
## Total fertility rate and mean age of women at the birth of the first child:

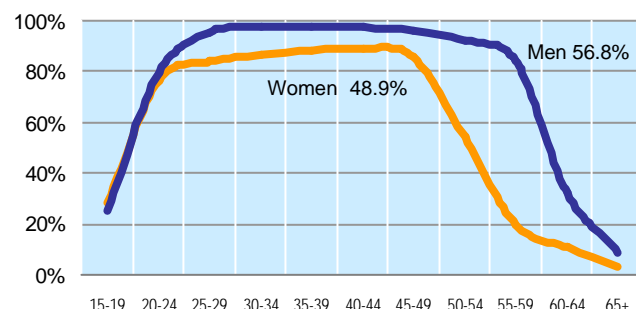


## Population by age, 2000:

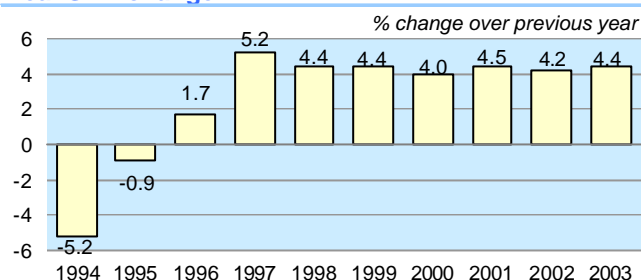

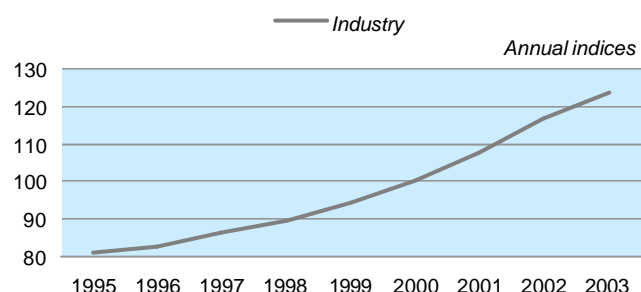

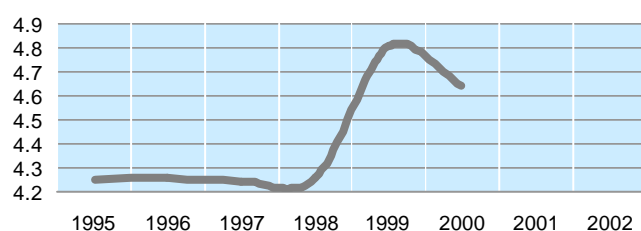

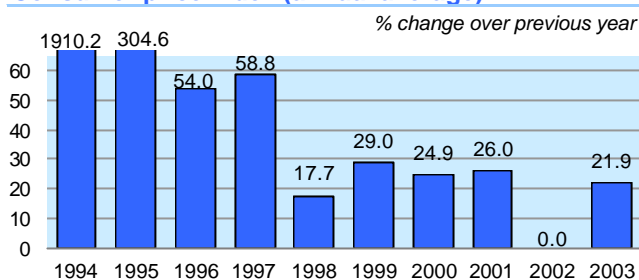

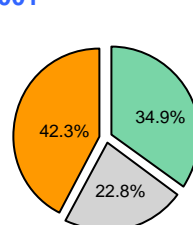

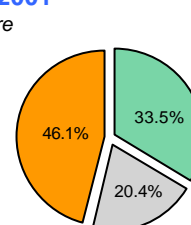

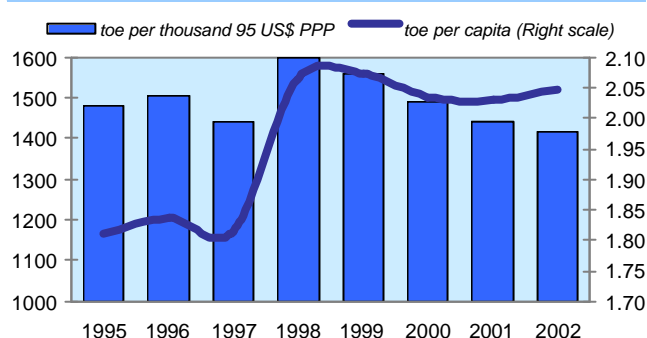
## GDP (value added) by major economic sectors: 2001



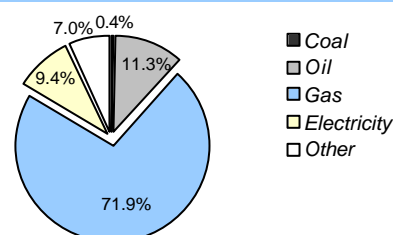
## Employment by major economic sectors: 2001
