The questionnaire requested information on national legislation, regulations and general information on railway tunnel safety with the objective of establishing the inventory proposed by the terms of reference of the Group. The Group may wish to consider replies on the questionnaire as submitted by member countries.

- (f) Brandschutz in Verkehrstunneln, Schlussbericht, BVBW, Germany (Informal document No. 13).
