AGREEMENT ON THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF PERISHABLE  
FOODSTUFFS AND ON THE SPECIAL EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR SUCH  
CARRIAGE (ATP)

GENEVA, 1 SEPTEMBER 1970

GERMANY: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 18 (2) (B) OF THE AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

On 2 July 2002, the Government of Germany notified the Secretary-General, pursuant to article 18 (2) (b) of the Agreement, that although it intended to accept the proposal, transmitted by C.N.106.2002.TREATIES-1 of 7 February 2002 to amend the Agreement, the conditions necessary for such acceptance were not yet fulfilled.

Consequently, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2 to 5 of article 18 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments to Annex 1, Appendix 1, will be deemed accepted only if, before the expiry of a period of nine months following the expiry of a period of six months as indicated in the said article (i.e., before 7 May 2003), the Government of Germany has not notified an objection to the proposed amendments.

However, if the Government of Germany notifies the depositary of its acceptance before 7 May 2003, the amendments will be deemed accepted on the date of receipt by the Secretary-General of the notification of acceptance.
