

## **Newsletter No.2 of February 2000:**

**Fussverkehr Schweiz (Swiss Pedestrian Mobility)**, a member of the International Federation of Pedestrians (IFP), will contribute to the Third Road Safety Week in the UN/ECE Region by organizing a symposium on road traffic safety.

The theme will be "Vision Zero - Traffic without Danger".

The two-day symposium will take place during the Third Road Safety Week, 4-5 May 2000 in Zurich. The symposium is being organized in cooperation with the Verkehrssicherheitsrat (Swiss Council for Traffic Safety) and under the auspices of the UN/ECE and is financially supported by the Fonds für Verkehrssicherheit (Swiss Traffic Safety Fund). During the Third Road Safety Week a new video will also be presented whose working title is "Coexistence in Traffic - Steps towards more Safety for Vulnerable Road Users". The video highlights the possibilities and limitations of all road users in traffic, concentrating on vulnerable users, and shows how traffic could be arranged to allow safe participation. The contents reflects the slogan of the Road Safety Week "Partnership on the Road Increases Safety". The video will be approximately 20 minutes long and available in French and German and, if finances allow, later also in English and Italian.
