Review of the accession to and implementation of the UNECE Agreements and Conventions

- In the field of land transportation the R. Macedonia has acceded to the following International Agreements:
 - Agreement on UN for (ATP) – in force from 20 Dec, 1999
 - Convention on agreement for international land transport of goods (CMR) - in force from 12 June, 1997
 - Custom Convention for international transport of goods with TIR carnets - in force from 2 Dec, 1993
 - UNECE legislation for approval of vehicle types in force from 1 April, 1998
 - Agreement on UN for the working of the drivers in the international trade- (AETR) - in force from the 10 Nov, 1999
 - Acceding to the Vienna Convention on UN (1968) in force from 20 December 1999.

➤ *Also through implementation of the Law on carriage of dangerous goods the following agreements- conventions are in force:*

- **International agreement on carriage of dangerous goods on road (ADR)**
- **International agreement on carriage of dangerous goods on rail (RID)**
- **International agreement on civil aviation and Annex 18 (ACAO)**
- **International agreement on protection of the humans life on sea (IMDG)**
- **World Post Convention and arrangement for postal packages**
- **European Agreement for international transport of dangerous goods on internal waterways with appropriate adjustments**

- According the EU legislation the approximation has been done within the following laws:
- **Law on public roads**
- **Law on road transport**
- **Law on carriage of dangerous goods**
- **Law on road transport safety- part with Min. of interior**
- **Railways law – in force from 2005**
- **Law on transformation of the PE Macedonian Railways in force from 2005**
- **Aviation law, to be adopted in the end of 2005/ 2006**
- **Law on rail carriage of dangerous goods to be adopted in 2006**

- In the field of civil aviation the R. Macedonia has acceded to the following International Agreements:
- **List of Protocols relating to an Amendment to the Convention on International Civil Aviation Membership to the different International organisations such as:**
 - **ICAO-International Civil Aviation Organization (form 09.01.1993)**
 - **ECAC- European Civil Aviation Conference (from 03.07.1997)**
 - **EUROCONTROL- European Organization for the Safety of Air Navigation (from 01.11.1998)**
 - **JAA - Joint Aviation Authorities (from 15.12.1999)**
