

Speaking points for the Executive Secretary, Ms. Olga Algayerova for the "Partnerships for Ambition: Unlocking the Full Potential of Local Climate Action"

First, thank you for the pleasure of joining you here today. I thoroughly enjoyed listening to these great ideas and concrete suggestions on how we can work together to localize climate action. I really like the title of this meeting: "Partnerships for Ambition".

Each one of us came here today with an idea, or their own initiative for climate action. I am, of course, not an exception. I must thank the organizers of this session as well their colleagues from the Nature-Based Solutions coalition, for allowing me to launch the "Trees in Cities Challenge" and thus invite mayors help mitigate climate change in cities.

Let us keep working together towards smarter, more sustainable, and more resilient cities.
