INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE FOR OPERATORS OF PLEASURE CRAFT (RESOLUTION NO. 40)

Revision of Resolution No. 40

Proposal by the European Boating Association

Note by the secretariat: At its thirty-third session, the Working Party on the Standardization of Technical and Safety Requirements in Inland Navigation (SC.3/WP.3) agreed with the proposal submitted by the European Boating Association (EBA) to amend Resolution No. 40 (TRANS/SC.3/147) in order to allow administrations to deliver ICCs to competent persons who are not nationals or residents of the administration's country and to add to a new annex with information on the acceptance and implementation details of the ICCs. SC.3/WP.3 forwarded the proposal to the Working Party on Inland Water Transport, noting that should SC.3 approve the proposal to add annex 4 to the resolution, SC.3/WP.3 could continue working on the content of the annex and submit the final version for the SC.3 thirty-third session. The Working Party may wish to review and, if appropriate, approve the amendment proposal. The Working Party may also wish to follow the SC.3/WP.3 recommendation to address Governments to encourage them to adopt Resolution No. 40 (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/66, para. 21) and to instruct the secretariat to issue such a statement on its behalf.
