2010 E-Road traffic census

Prepared by the secretariat

- 1. During its seventy-first session, the Inland Transport Committee adopted:
 - Resolution No. 259: E-Road Traffic Census of Motor Traffic and Inventory of Standards and Parameters on Main International Traffic Arteries in Europe in 2010 ("2010 E-Road Traffic Census"); and
- 2. This resolution requested Government to inform the Executive Secretary of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) by **30 September 2009** whether they agree to implement the provisions of the resolution.
- 3. Circular letters were sent to all Ministries of Foreign Affairs and reminder was sent to the delegates to the UNECE Working Party on Transport Statistics.
- 4. The secretariat received information from the following countries on their intention to implement the resolution on:
 - <u>2010 E-Road Traffic Census</u>: Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Luxembourg, Poland, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Switzerland and Turkey;
- 5. During its seventy-second session, the Inland Transport Committee **invited** UNECE member States who had not yet informed the secretariat about their intention to take part in the 2010 E-Road traffic census complying with Committee Resolutions No. 259 to do so as soon as possible, and **urged** all UNECE member States to submit the required traffic data by **1 November 2011**.
