Amendments to Resolution No. 40, “International Certificate for Operators of Pleasure Craft”

Note by the secretariat*

I. Mandate

1. This document is submitted in line with cluster 5: Inland Waterway Transport, paragraph 5.1 of the programme of work 2018–2019 (ECE/TRANS/2018/21/Add.1) adopted by the Inland Transport Committee (ITC) at its eightieth session (20–23 February 2018).

2. Based on the answers to the questionnaire on the application of the International Certificate for Operators of Pleasure Craft (ICC), education and training for operators of pleasure craft (ICC) collected following the decision of the Working Party on the Standardization of Technical and Safety Requirements in Inland Navigation at its fifty-fourth session (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/108, para. 95), the secretariat has prepared an update to annex IV to resolution No. 40.¹

3. Working Party on Inland Water Transport (SC.3) may wish to amend annex IV to resolution No. 40 as proposed in this document. SC.3 may also wish to take note of ICC specimens, transmitted by Ireland, Lithuania and South Africa, which are reproduced in this document. They are also available in the database of ICC specimens maintained by the Economic Commission for Europe (ECE) at www.unece.org/trans/main/sc3/icc_resolution_40.html.

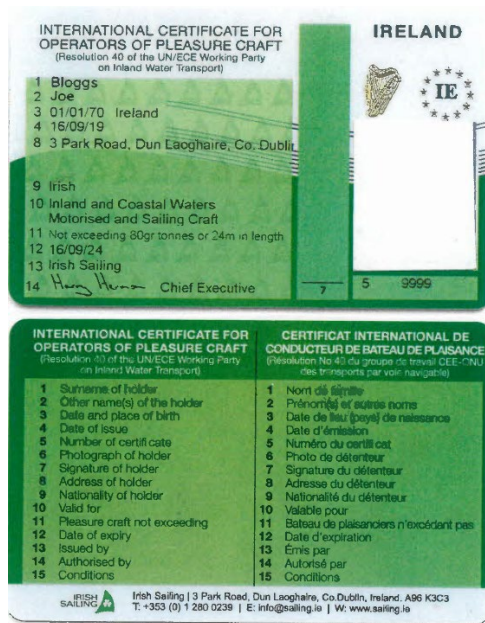
