PROTOCOL ON COMBINED TRANSPORT ON INLAND WATERWAYS TO  
THE EUROPEAN AGREEMENT ON IMPORTANT INTERNATIONAL  
COMBINED TRANSPORT LINES AND RELATED INSTALLATIONS (AGTC)  
OF 1991

GENEVA, 17 JANUARY 1997

HUNGARY: APPROVAL

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 27 September 2007, with:

Reservation (Original: English)

"In accordance with Article 12 the Republic of Hungary does not consider itself bound by  
Article 11 of this Protocol concerning arbitration and shall not apply it."

Declaration (Original: English)

"The Government of the Republic of Hungary hereby declare, that the approval of the Protocol  
cannot be interpreted as a commitment to fulfil the required work concerning the adaptation of any  
inland waterway for combined transport not belonging to the jurisdiction of the Republic of Hungary  
but mentioned in the Annex to the Protocol.

Since this Protocol is a Protocol to the 1991 European Agreement on Important International  
Combined Transport Lines and Related Installations (AGTC) and since in particular, its articles 6, 8 and  
16 require that parties to this Protocol must be and remain parties to the AGTC, the Protocol is clearly  
and intimately linked to the AGTC.
