The Global Indicator Framework



- The global indicator framework for Sustainable Development Goals was developed by the Inter-Agency and Expert Group on SDG Indicators (IAEG-SDGs)
- Designed to measure progress at the global level
- Adopted at the highest political level in <u>A/RES/71/313</u> by the General Assembly in 2017:

Work of the Statistical Commission pertaining to the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development

 Preparation of the 2025 comprehensive review of the global indicator framework is ongoing.

The Global Indicator Framework



Consists of 231 indicators

- Only 4 indicators directly related to transport:
 - 3.6.1 Death rate due to road traffic injuries
 - 9.1.1 Proportion of the rural population who live within 2 km of an all-season road
 - 9.1.2 Passenger and freight volumes, by mode of transport
 - 11.2.1 Proportion of population that has convenient access to public transport, by sex, age and persons with disabilities
- Custodian Agencies collect data from countries or produce indicators themselves and report to the United Nations Statistics Division

National Reporting on SDGs



National Indicators have support from the highest political level:

- Encourages Member States to develop practical ambitious national responses to overall SDG implementation and conduct regular and inclusive reviews of progress at the national and subnational levels. (A/Res/70/1 Transforming our world: the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development)
- "the global indicator framework [...] will be complemented by indicators at the regional and national levels, which will be developed by Member States." (A/RES/71/313 - Work of the Statistical Commission pertaining to the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development)

National Reporting on SDGs



Voluntary National Reviews

- National reviews are expected to serve as a basis for the regular reviews by the high-level political forum (HLPF)
- Voluntary, state-led, undertaken by both developed and developing countries, and involve multiple stakeholders

New: <u>A/RES/77/283</u> encourages that VNRs should be presented with a Country-led evaluation component

National Indicator Frameworks



 Flagship publication of the UNECE Steering Group on Statistics for SDGs — <u>Road Map on Statistics for</u> <u>SDGs (second edition)</u>:

"A set of national indicators to complement the global indicator framework to measure progress towards achieving sustainable development to provide the perspective of national policies and priorities."

National Indicator Frameworks



- Essential to measure progress at national level
- Take into account country-specific contexts
- Important for Voluntary National Reviews

- Must avoid cherry-picking of SDGs
- Balance between benefit and reporting burden
- Should consider indicators currently in use (regional indicators or national indicators for other purposes)





Other indicator frameworks



Eurostat SDG indicator framework


- Average CO2 emissions from new passenger cars (SDG 12 & SDG 13)
- Share of buses and trains in inland passenger transport (SDG 11)

Global Set of Climate Change Statistics and Indicators

- Number of (fossil-driven) vehicles per capita
- Vehicle miles travelled per capita
- Share of energy- and transport-related taxes as a percentage of total taxes and social contributions

Availability of National Indicator Sets





- Questionnaire sent to National Statistical Offices
- 50 responses (approx. 80%)

 80 percent of responding countries have a National Indicator set
