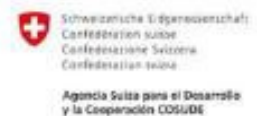

Waste is the third sector that emits methane (20%)

(360 KG/PERSON-YR)
50-60% ORGANIC WASTE

9% UNKNOWN DESTINATION



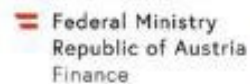
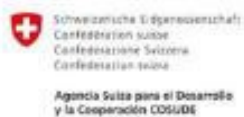
Adequate waste management and a transition to a circular economy is a key to mitigate methane



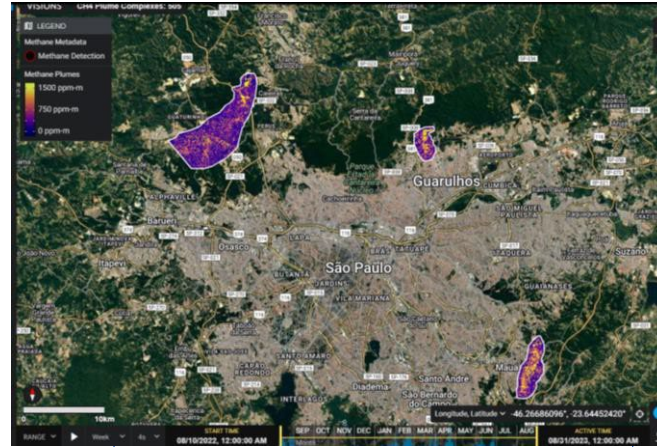
Too **Good** to Waste

Initiative to mitigate methane emissions from waste in Latin America and the Caribbean

- Improve waste management aligned with circular economy.
- At least 30% of methane emissions reduction in solid waste operations financed by the IDB.
