I have the honour to write to you in response to your letter dated 1 August 2014 concerning the follow-up action by Armenia with respect to the implementation of decision VI/2 of the Meeting of the Parties to the Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (Espoo Convention), paragraphs 45 and 46, and your request that the matter be included on the agenda of the upcoming session of the Implementation Committee under the Convention.

The provisional agenda for the Implementation Committee's thirty-first session (see UN doc. ECE/MP.EIA/IC/2014/3, entitled "annotated provisional agenda for the thirty-first session", available from <a href="http://www.unece.org/index.php?id=34094">http://www.unece.org/index.php?id=34094</a>), already includes item 4, Follow-up to decision VI/2.
