Glossary and abbreviations

Glossary:

Population equivalent (1 p.e.):

The organic biodegradable load having a five-day biochemical oxygen demand (BOD5) of 60 g of oxygen per day

Primary/mechanical wastewater treatment: Treatment of wastewater by a physical

and/or chemical process involving settlement of suspended solids, or other process in which the biochemical oxygen demand (BOD5) of the incoming wastewater is reduced by at least 20% before discharge and the total suspended solids of the incoming wastewater are reduced by at least 50%. To avoid double counting, water subjected to more than one type of treatment should be reported under the highest level of treatment only.

Secondary/biological wastewater treatment: Post-primary treatment of wastewater by a process generally involving biological or other treatment with a secondary settlement or other process, resulting in a biochemical oxygen demand (BOD5) removal of at least 70%. To avoid double counting, water subjected to more than one type of treatment should be reported under the highest level of treatment only.

Tertiary/advanced wastewater treatment:

Treatment (additional to secondary treatment) of nitrogen and/or phosphorous and/or any other pollutant affecting the quality or a specific use of water: microbiological pollution, colour etc. The different possible treatment efficiencies ('organic pollution removal' of at least 95% for BOD5, 85% for COD, 'nitrogen removal' of at least 70%, 'phosphorus removal' of at least 80% and 'microbiological removal') cannot be added and are exclusive.
