Glossary, abbreviations, legends and units of measurement

Glossary:

Final Energy Consumption:	Energy Consumption in Industry, Transport and Other sectors (households, commercial and public services, agriculture and forestry, fishery and non-specified consumption) + Non-energy use. It excludes deliveries of energy for transformation, use by the energy producing industries, and distribution losses.
International dollar:	Monetary unit used by the World Bank for the calculation of the gross domestic product (GDP) in purchasing power parity (PPP).
Total energy consumption:	Primary production + Imports - export - bins + stock changes.
