Entry into force of amendments to annex 2, article 3, paragraphs 9 and 10 to annex 7, Part I, article 4, paragraphs 9 and 10 of the TIR Convention $^{\rm i}$

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

By 1 July 2005, none of the Contracting Parties to the above-mentioned Convention had communicated an objection to the Secretary-General. Consequently, in accordance with the provisions of article 60 (1) of the Convention, the amendments to Annex 2, Article 3, paragraphs 9 and 10 and to Annex 7, Part I, Article 4, paragraphs 9 and 10 of the Convention will enter into force on 1 October 2005 for all Contracting Parties.
