- SafeTIR messages received: **673'633**
- Percentage of messages transmitted within 1 day (*): **91%**
- Average transmission delay: **1.6 days**

- Customs queries through the RTS database: **1'009'073**
- Reconciliation requests: **3'727**
- Replies to reconciliation requests: **1'992 (53%)**
