In a letter dated 18 January 2000, the Finnish Government transmitted the following amendment proposal:

A. Main roads

- (1) West-east orientation
 - (b) <u>Intermediate roads</u>

Road E 8 - Extension from Tornio to Turku

<u>New overall reference</u> : E 8 Tromsø – Nordkjosbotn - Skibotn - Kilpisjärvi - Tornio - Oulu - Vaasa - Turku

Road E 4 - Delete section between Tornio and Kemi to avoid double numbering with E 8.

<u>New overall reference</u>: E 4 Helsingborg - Jönköping - Norrköping - Södertälje - Stockholm - Sundsvall - Umeå - Luleå - Haparanda - Tornio

Justification

The proposed extension of the E 8 is partly motorway but mainly all-purpose, two-lane ordinary road. The road connection from Oulu to Turku is one of the most important main roads in Finland (national road number 8) and it is also proposed to be included in the TEN road network. Situated on the coast there are several seaports and connections to Europe. From Turku and Naantali there are good and numerous ferry connections to Sweden all year round. The extension of the E 8 is thus very important for international traffic.
