AMENDMENTS TO AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 1968 CONVENTIONS ON ROAD TRAFFIC AND ON ROAD SIGNS AND SIGNALS AND THE 1971 EUROPEAN AGREEMENTS SUPPLEMENTING THEM

Position of the Russian Federation on the amendments to the Convention on Road Traffic concerning the use of mobile phones

Following the discussion of the issue at the thirty-seventh and thirty-eighth sessions of the UN/ECE Inland Transport Committee, we consider it advisable to adopt alternative B, proposed by the Government of Israel (TRANS/WP.1/CRP.1/Add.1), taking into account the predominantly editorial amendments. Thus, the following text must be included in article 8, paragraph 5:

"It is forbidden for a driver of any vehicle to use a mobile or car phone while driving, unless the telephone is not hand-held or otherwise held by the driver."
