Paragraph SCOPE, renumber as paragraph 0. and amend to read (including the insertion of a reference to a new footnote 1/ and a new footnote 1/):

"0. SCOPE

This Regulation applies to adaptive front-lighting systems (AFS) for vehicles of categories M and N 1/.

Paragraph 1.3., the reference to footnote 1/ and footnote 1/, renumber as footnote 2/.

Paragraph 2.2.2., subparagraphs (a), (b), (c) and (g), the references to footnote 2/ and footnote 2/, renumber as footnote 3/.

Paragraph 2.2.2., subparagraphs (b) and (f), the references to footnote 3/ and footnote 3/, renumber as footnote 4/.

Paragraph 4.2.1.1., the reference to footnote 4/ and footnote 4/, renumber as footnote 5/ and amend to read:

"5/ 1 for Germany, ..., 51 for the Republic of Korea, [52 for Malaysia and 53 for Thailand]. Subsequent numbers shall be assigned .... "
