Classification and labelling of Ozone Depleting Chemicals:  
Consequential amendments to Annex 3 of the GHS

Note by the secretariat

At the request of the Sub-Committee (ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/30, para. 35), the secretariat reproduces hereafter the proposal for amendment to Annex 3 of the GHS (following the adoption of Chapter 4.2 “Hazardous to the ozone layer”) which was initially submitted by the Organization for the Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) (UN/SCEGHS/15/INF.33) and provisionally adopted by the Sub-Committee at its fifteenth session.

**Proposal of amendment to Annex 3 of the GHS**Section 1

At the end of Table A3.1.3 (page 301 of the English version), add a new row to read as follows:

H420	<b>Harms public health and the environment by destroying ozone in the upper atmosphere</b>	Hazardous to the ozone layer (Chapter 4.2)	1
