**RESOLUTION NO. 40 ON INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE FOR OPERATORS OF
PLEASURE CRAFT**

Submitted by the European Boating Association

Note by the Secretariat:

It is recalled that at its thirty-second session, the Working Party considered and approved the proposal submitted by the European Boating Association (EBA) to add to Resolution No. 40 a new annex with information on the acceptance and implementation details of International Certificate for operators of Pleasure Craft (ICC) (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/2008/11). The Working Party also agreed with the proposal to amend Resolution No. 40 in order to allow administrations to deliver ICCs to competent persons who are not nationals or residents of the administration's country. However, the Working Party considered that the new wording to that effect could be improved and requested that EBA in cooperation with the secretariat prepare draft amendments to Resolution No. 40 for the June session (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/64, para. 22).

The Working Party may wish to review the draft amendments to the body of the resolution and the first draft of the new annex 4, and issue instructions to the secretariat on preparing a proposal for the Working Party on Inland Water Transport (SC.3).
