Directive 2006/22/EC<sup>1</sup> on the implementation of the driving and rest time regulation contained an Annex III with only very basic indications on what the Commission regarded as infringements against the driving and rest time regulation<sup>2</sup> and the tachograph regulation<sup>3</sup>.

A common understanding of the categorisation of infringements is desirable in order to provide a common basis for the risk rating systems which Member States have to introduce according to Article 9(1) of Directive 2006/22/EC, to harmonise the application of the social legislation relating to road transport and to facilitate the exchange of information on infringements between Member States.

Commission Directive 2009/5/EC introduces therefore a new Annex III to Directive 2006/22/EC, giving guidelines on the categorisation of the most common infringements against Regulation (EC) No 561/2006 and Council Regulation (EEC) No 3821/85 by dividing them into three categories: very serious infringements, serious infringements, minor infringements.
