
ORIGINAL TEM AND TER MASTER PLAN

was elaborated under the auspices of the UNECE in 2003 – 2005 with the aim of establishing the investment strategy for development of road, rail and combined transport infrastructure in Central and Eastern Europe and with the following main objectives:

- Identification of backbone road/motorway and rail networks
- Assessment and prioritization of identified projects
- Funding requirements and availability of resources
- Support of extension of the TEN-T network
- Further development of Pan-European Transport Corridors
- Border crossing facilitation
- Promotion of TEM and TER projects' goals
- Promotion of intermodality
- Contribution to the European transport integration




