





Annual Monthly Average Fatal Road Collisions 1997 - 2008





Figure 4: Number of Serious Injury Collisions, 1985-2007




Fatalities and serious injuries 1997 - 2008








Age of road collisions fatalities - 2008




Fig.4: Road deaths per million inhabitants in 2009 (with road deaths per million inhabitants in 2001 for comparison)
