Proposal for Corrigendum 2 to Revision 5 to Regulation No. 48
(Installation of lighting and light-signalling devices)

Submitted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling */

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE) at its sixty-second session. It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2009/2, as amended by para. 8 of the report. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/62, para. 8).

*/ In accordance with the programme of work of the Inland Transport Committee for 2006-2010 (ECE/TRANS/166/Add.1, programme activity 02.4), the World Forum will develop, harmonize and update Regulations in order to enhance performance of vehicles. The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

Paragraph 6.17.4.3., amend to read:

"6.17.4.3. In length: At least ...

...

If the structure, design or the operational use of the vehicle makes it impossible to comply with such a requirement, this distance may be increased to 4 m. The distance between ..."

Paragraph 6.18.4.3., amend to read:

"6.18.4.3. In length: at least The distance between two adjacent side-marker lamps shall not exceed 3 m. If the structure, design or the operational use of the vehicle makes it impossible to comply with such a requirement, this distance may be increased to 4 m.
